Tradesman Tools Introduces the FenceRoller

FenceRoller retrieves plastic barrier fence and up to 100' of silt fence

MAPLE LAKE, MN — August 14, 2009 — Tradesman Tools announced the second tool in its product line geared toward jobsite professionals. The FenceRoller is a tool that allows one man to effortlessly roll up and secure plastic barrier fencing and short runs of silt fence in seconds from a comfortable standing position. Currently these materials are pulled off the jobsite by hand requiring workers to crawl on the ground which is often painful to the knees and stressful on the back. The tangled mess of fence usually gets disposed of in landfills along with other jobsite waste. With the FenceRoller, fencing can easily be reclaimed and re-used. Doug Piegras, the designer of the FenceRoller and President of Tradesman Tools states “It makes good sense economically and environmentally to re-use your plastic fencing because it takes less than 30 seconds to retrieve a \$40 roll of fence.”

An Innovative and Economical Solution

The FenceRoller is the only tool of its kind, is patent pending, and built to stand up to tough jobsite conditions. Simply pull the end of the plastic fence between the two tubes, turn the crank handle, and in less than 30 seconds your fence is completely rolled up and ready to secure and slide right off. If you have a large volume of fencing to roll, remove the crank handle and insert the 3/8” drill adapter for plastic fencing. Just pull the trigger on your drill and watch it roll. To roll up silt fence, place two short PVC pipes over the FenceRoller tubes so the silt fence will slide off easily. Pull the material between the two tubes, turn the crank handle, and up to

100 feet of silt fence is completely rolled up and ready to secure and slide right off in less than 60 seconds.

The FenceRoller is made to be easily transported to jobsites because it fits inside a pickup toolbox, is only 59” long, and can be assembled and disassembled in three easy steps without any tools. Use the receiver hitch of a pickup truck or mount it to a trailer using the trailer mount bracket (available separately).
